Church Membership - What It Is and Why It's Necessary

- I. The local church is the body of Christ.
 - 1. 1Co 1:2a Unto the church of God which is at Corinth...
 - 2. 1Co 12:27 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.
- II. The local church, which is the body of Christ, is said to have members like a human body.
 - 1. **1Co 12:12** For as the body is one, and hath many <u>members</u>, and all the <u>members</u> of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.
 - 2. **1Co 12:13** For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.
 - 3. **1Co 12:14** For the body is not one <u>member</u>, but many.
 - 4. **1Co 12:15** If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
 - 5. **1Co 12:16** And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?
 - 6. **1Co 12:17** If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?
 - 7. **1Co 12:18** But now hath God set the <u>members</u> every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.
 - 8. 1Co 12:19 And if they were all one <u>member</u>, where were the body?
 - 9. **1Co 12:20** But now are they many <u>members</u>, yet but one body.
 - 10. **1Co 12:21** And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.
 - 11. **1Co 12:22** Nay, much more those <u>members</u> of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:
 - 12. **1Co 12:23** And those <u>members</u> of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.
 - 13. **1Co 12:24** For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked:
 - 14. **1Co 12:25** That there should be no schism in the body; but that the <u>members</u> should have the same care one for another.
 - 15. **1Co 12:26** And whether one <u>member</u> suffer, all the <u>members</u> suffer with it; or one <u>member</u> be honoured, all the <u>members</u> rejoice with it.
 - 16. **1Co 12:27** Now ye are the body of Christ, and <u>members</u> in particular.

III. A believer becomes a member of a local church by means of water baptism.

- 1. Act 2:37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?
- 2. Act 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, <u>Repent</u>, and <u>be baptized</u> every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- 3. Act 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.
- 4. Act 2:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord <u>added to the church</u> daily such as should be saved.
- IV. Once a person becomes a church member, they are responsible to:
 - 1. Continue worshiping God with the church on a regular basis including keeping the ordinances of communion and feetwashing.

- A. Act 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
- B. Joh 13:13-15 Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am. 14) If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; <u>ye also ought to wash one another's feet</u>. 15) For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.
- C. **1Co 11:1-2** Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ. 2) Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you.
- 2. Be under the instruction and authority of the pastor.
 - A. **Heb 13:7** Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.
 - B. **Heb 13:17** <u>Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves</u>: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.
- 3. Be subject and accountable to other church members.
 - A. **1Pe 5:5** Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, <u>all of you be</u> <u>subject one to another</u>, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.
 - B. Eph 5:21 <u>Submitting yourselves one to another</u> in the fear of God.
- 4. Love the brethren in the church and bear their burdens with them.
 - A. **1Pe 1:22** Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart <u>fervently</u>:
 - B. Gal 6:2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.
- 5. Be unified in doctrine with the church.
 - A. **1Co 1:10** Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
 - B. **Eph 4:11** And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;
 - C. **Eph 4:12** For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:
 - D. **Eph 4:13** Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:
- 6. Be held to the Biblical standard to morality and be subject to church discipline when failing to do so.
 - A. **1Co 5:11** But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.
 - B. **1Co 5:12** For what have I to do to judge them also that are without? <u>do not ye</u> judge them that are within?
 - C. **1Co 5:13** But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore <u>put away from among</u> <u>yourselves that wicked person</u>.
- 7. Not forsake the church assembly.
 - A. **Heb 10:25** <u>Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together</u>, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
